#### 1. Introduction

The **DoubleDome SEO Meta Updater Plugin** makes it fast and easy to manage your website's SEO metadata in bulk.

With just a few clicks, you can **export** SEO titles and descriptions for all pages and posts, **edit them in Excel or Google Sheets**, and **import them back** into WordPress — all without touching code or your SEO plugin's database manually.

This tool is perfect for:

- Website owners and marketers who want full control over meta titles and descriptions.
- SEO agencies managing large sites or multiple clients.
- Developers looking to save time on SEO updates during migrations or audits.



## 2. Features Overview

## 3. Installation & Setup

#### **Free Version**

- 1. Go to **Plugins** → **Add New** in your WordPress dashboard.
- 2. Search for "DoubleDome SEO Meta Updater."
- 3. Click **Install Now**, then **Activate**.

#### **Pro Version**

- 1. Download the ZIP file provided after purchase.
- 2. Go to Plugins → Add New → Upload Plugin.
- 3. Choose the ZIP file and click **Install Now**, then **Activate**.
- 4. (*Important:*) If you already have the Free version installed, deactivate and remove it first. There's **no automatic upgrade path** install Pro as a separate plugin.

### 4. Exporting SEO Meta Data

- 1. Navigate to **SEO Meta Updater** → **Export** in your WordPress admin panel.
- 2. Choose the export type:
  - o Free: All indexed content automatically.
  - o **Pro:** Use filters to narrow by Post Type, Category, Date, or Status.
- Click Export.
- 4. A clean CSV file will download to your computer one row per post/page, including:
  - Post ID



- o URL
- o Title
- Meta Description
- SEO Plugin Source (if applicable)

## 5. Importing SEO Meta Data

- 1. Open your exported CSV file in Excel or Google Sheets.
- 2. Update the Title and Meta Description columns only.
- Save the file as a .CSV with UTF-8 encoding.
- 4. Go to **SEO Meta Updater** → **Import**.
- 5. Choose your file and upload it.
- 6. The plugin will automatically match rows based on Post ID or URL.
- 7. Click **Import Now** to apply updates.

### **Notes:**

Unmatched rows are skipped safely.
Only users with Administrator privileges can import data.

## 6. Advanced Features (Pro Only)

The Pro version adds robust export and filtering tools to manage large or complex sites.

#### **Available Filters:**



- Post Type: Posts, Pages, Products, or any Custom Post Type.
- Post Status: Published, Draft, Scheduled, or Private.
- Taxonomy: Filter by Categories, Tags, or custom taxonomies.
- **Date Range:** Export SEO data created or modified within a specific timeframe.

#### **Advanced CSV Handling:**

- Flexible column matching to support different naming conventions.
- Enhanced error handling with validation messages before import.

### 7. Permissions & Safeguards

- Only Administrator roles can access plugin tools.
- Every file is validated for correct format before import.
- Invalid or missing columns will trigger a warning, preventing accidental data loss.
- Changes are safely written to post meta fields (no direct database overwrite).

## 8. Troubleshooting

Issue	Cause	Solution
CSV won't import	File format not UTF-8 or	Re-save file as UTF-8 and check
	missing headers	column names



Some rows skipped Post ID/URL not matched Confirm correct ID or URL column

in CSV

Export includes empty No data set in SEO plugin Add content and re-export

meta

"Permission denied" User not admin Ensure admin privileges

### 9. Best Practices

Always export a backup CSV before importing.

- Limit large imports (e.g., >1000 rows) to smaller batches for safety.
- Keep your SEO plugin (Yoast, Rank Math, etc.) updated for full compatibility.
- Review titles/descriptions for length and keyword relevance before re-importing.
- After import, clear cache and re-index your sitemap if needed.
